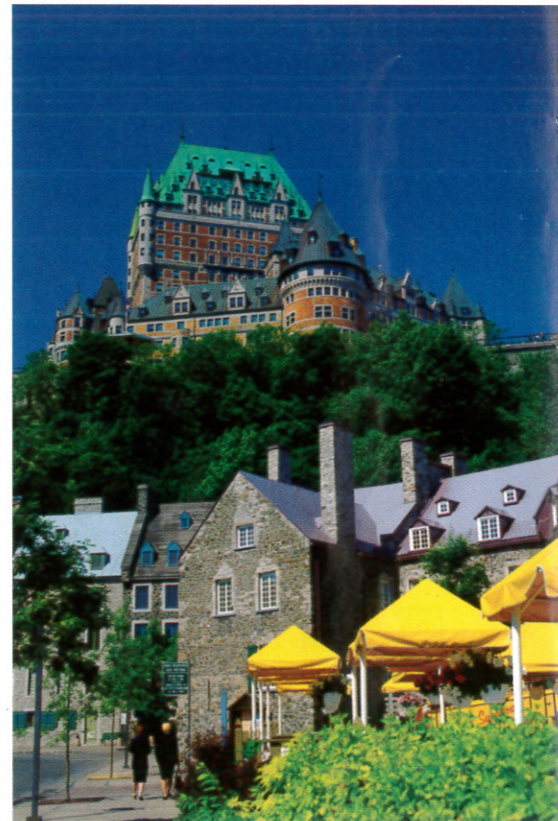
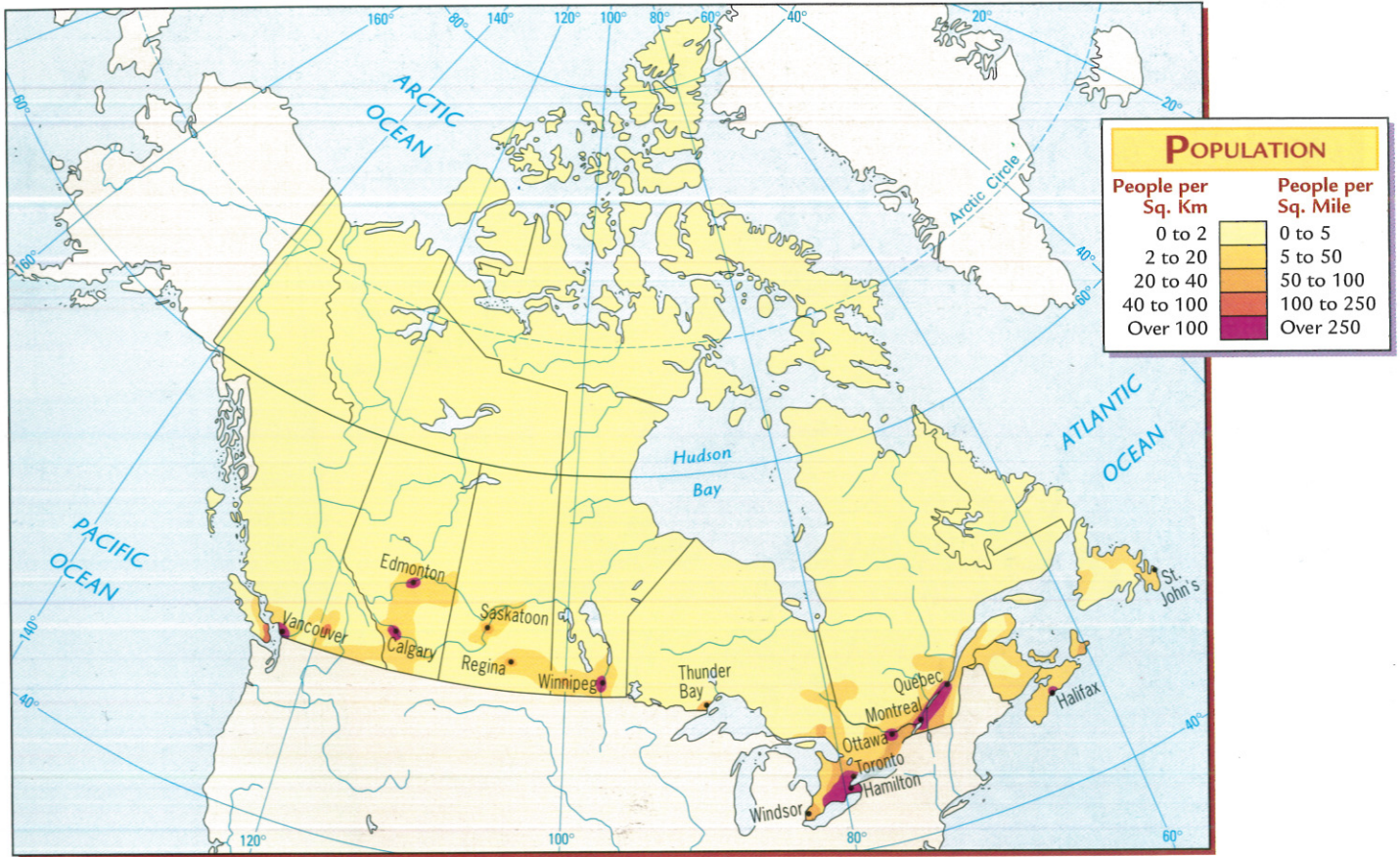


MAJOR HIGHWAYS AND AIRPORTS

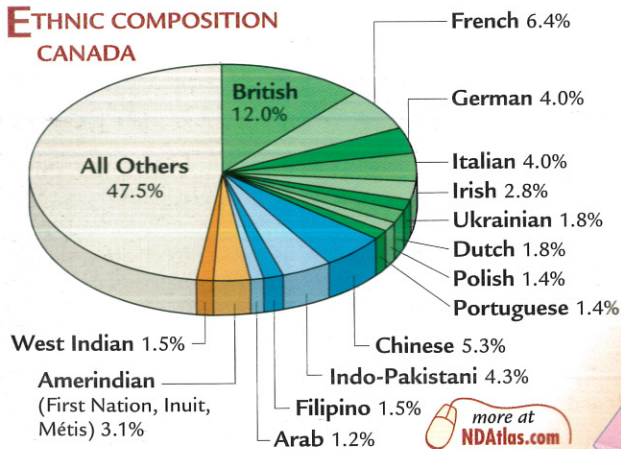

Located on the St. Lawrence River, Quebec is the oldest city in Canada. Quebec is a World Heritage City that hosts over 9 million visitors a year.



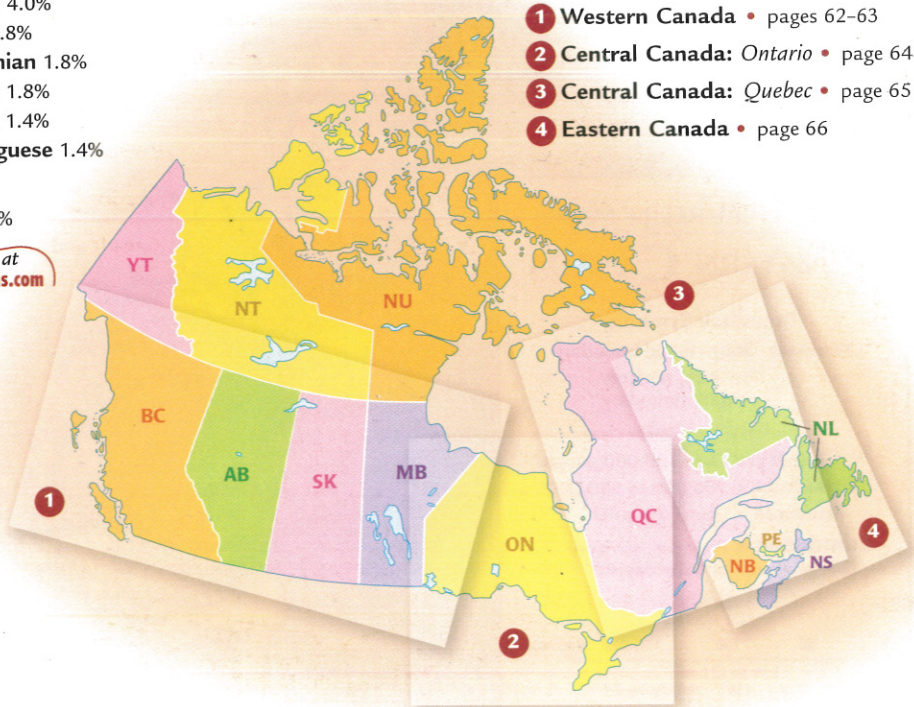
ETHNIC COMPOSITION CANADA



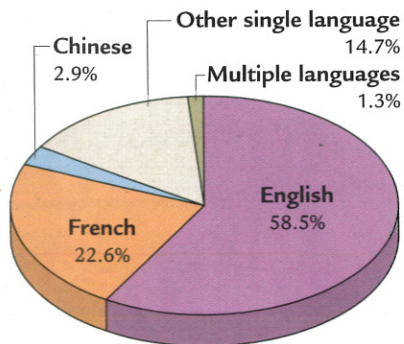
